TRURO POLICE ANNOUNCE TRAFFIC DELAYS

TRURO, MA – September 9, 2010 - Truro, MA: Chief Lundborn and the members of The Truro Police Department is making this notification informing the public of heavy traffic areas and traffic delays as a result of scheduled Truro Treasures events this fall.

- **Saturday Sept 18, 2009 10AM – 4PM** Route 6 near the Truro Central School traffic will be heavy do to a craft fair and Truro Treasures related activities.
- **Saturday Sept 18, 2009 10AM – 5PM** Standish Road may be heavily congested due to the silent auction.
- **Sunday Sept 19, 2009 8AM – 11AM** Depot Road, Pamet Harbor and South Pamet Road, including the Ballston Beach Parking Lot Area will be available for limited traffic use due to a scheduled 5K Run.
- **Sunday Sept 19, 2009 10AM – 4PM** Route 6 near the Truro Central School traffic will be heavy do to a craft fair and Truro Treasures related activities.
- **Sunday Sept 19, 2009 11AM – 2PM** Route 6 near the Seamen's Bank traffic will be heavy do to a car show and Truro Treasures related activities.
- **Sunday Sept 19, 2009 2PM – 6PM** Shore Road (Route 6A) near the Truro Vineyards Winery traffic will be heavy along Shore Road due to Truro Treasures event. South Hollow Road will be closed from Shore Road to Route 6 so that it may be used for parking.
